LEARNING ACTIVITY FOR ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND COOPERATION

The MyDigiCoop project brought together several teachers and education professionals to evaluate the results of the project.

To create efficient and useful resources, they need to be tested by end-users. This is what the MyDigiCoop project accomplished in Helsinki (Finland) last January.

Between 25 and 27 January 2023, 14 teachers and education professionals as "companions" of social entrepreneurs met with the MyDigiCoop team at the Pasila Campus of the Haaga-Helia University of Applied Sciences, to test the resources and results developed during the project.





Over the course of three days, attendees were able to delve into the world of cooperative social entrepreneurship with professionals who discussed topics such as the *Mondragón cooperative* movement, specific cases of business management and the role of co-operatives in the social economy. They were also able to learn about the structures of entrepreneurial ecosystems through best practices and receive training in "*accompaniment skills*" - digital social skills to promote social entrepreneurship.

All this knowledge was put at the service of the attendees with the aim of acquiring training in this area and being able to correctly assess and evaluate the project's tools and resources: **the General Platform and the Guidelines**.

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The event began with the intervention of Vicente Atxa, Rector of Mondragon Unibertsitatea, and Nagore Ipiña, Dean of the Faculty of Humanities and Education Sciences, who introduced the event and presented the project. It was also attended by relevant people in the field of education, such as Mr Joan Subirats, Minister of Universities of Spain, who participated online and spoke about the social and cooperative economy and the importance of promoting social and cooperative entrepreneurship in higher education.

Throughout the event, several relevant aspects related to the main objective of the project, to disseminate and promote the sociocooperative mentality among students and teachers in higher education, were highlighted:

- 1. debate on the importance and relevance of working on the social economy and cooperativism at the university level and in other types of higher education.
- 2. creation of a space for reflection.
- 3. sharing current experiences in Europe.

As an added value of the event itself, it is necessary to highlight that all the partners of the project attended and explained to all the attendees the situation in their countries (Spain, Romania, Finland and Germany), with the aim of having a more global vision of cooperation and social entrepreneurship in Europe.

The conference was open to the public, although it was particularly aimed at higher education teaching staff, research staff and students wishing to work on this subject at the university level, as well as social economy actors.

09 LAST TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING OF MYDIGICOOP

Throughout the two years of the project, several meetings have been held between the partners developing MyDigiCoop, but only one transnational meeting could be face-to-face, due to the health crisis related to COVID-19. This fact added value to this final meeting of the project, held in early February and hosted by HUHEZI in Mondragon (Spain). At last, all MyDidiCoop partners were able to meet face-to-face to discuss and share efficiently the final steps to continue the smooth running of the project, assess the quality of the work done by each partner and to better coordinate the next tasks.

In this meeting, the partners shared their general vision of the MyDigiCoop project, as well as their satisfaction with the results developed during the project:

- An assessment was made of the work done and the results obtained with the MyDigiCoop Open Iterative Platform, the tool that allows to the assessment of the competences in relation to social-cooperative entrepreneurship of the participants.
- As part of the second outcome of the project, MyDigiCoop has worked on the development of a Teachers' Manual, designed for educators working in the field of social-cooperative entrepreneurship in various undergraduate programmes, with the aim of connecting these educators to the content and use of the abovementioned platform.





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To conclude, the positive reach of the project in terms of communication was discussed, analysing each of the project's communication channels, and attention was paid to the results of MyDigiCoop in terms of impact and quality.

Once the project meeting was over, the project partners went to the Otalora Topagunea, Center for Management and Cooperative Development at Mondragon, with the aim of getting to know how the Mondragon Cooperative works, founded in 1956 and which today has 83 autonomous and independent cooperatives, around 80,000 people and 12 R&D centres, works.

To close the day, the MyDigiCoop team enjoyed a meal with local products and an incomparable landscape.
